GO GROUP ICE-BREAKER

Supplies Needed:

- Masking Tape

“Relay”

Preparation: Divide the children into two groups (teams). Create start/finish lines with provided tape.

Instructions: Each team will line-up behind the first taped line and, one at a time, the children will run to the second line and do an action (Example: 10 jumping jacks, 5 circles, or 5 push-ups). Next person in line cannot advance until tagged by teammate. First team to have everyone complete the task wins.

Object: All the kids need to be “Involved” in order to win.



INSPECTION

ACTIVITY TO INSPECT & EMPHASIZE THE GO ANSWER

Supplies Needed:

- None

“Story Time”

Preparation: Kids sit in a circle

Instructions: As a group, you are going to create a story based off of a scenario. Each child will contribute a phrase or sentence to the story. It is the leader’s responsibility to keep everyone “involved” in a kid-friendly storyline.

Example:

Scenario: “Last summer, while on vacation...”

Child 1: We had to drive 20 hours to Florida

Child 2: Where we saw 10 alligators

Child 3: My brother wanted one as a pet

Child 4, 5, and so on...

APPLY THE GO ANSWER TO KIDS’ DAILY LIVES & OPEN DISCUSSION ON THE TOPIC

Supplies Needed:

- None

- **Connect time:** Go around the circle and have kids tell the group their first name and their favorite sports team.

- **What does PILOT stands for?** Prepared. Involved. Loving. Open to God. Team Player.

- **What are some ways we can be involved?** (Answers will vary: Worship at church, serve,)

- **Our verse in Colossians says, “to work for God and not people.” What does it mean to work for God and not people?** (Answers will vary.)

- **How can you turn your chores into a way to serve God?** (Answers will vary: be obedient, good attitude, do my best.)
