## GO GROUP ICE-BREAKER

### Supplies Needed:

- Pool Noodle
- Masking Tape

### “Pool Noodle Race”

**Preparation:** Create two lines with provided tape roughly 20-30 feet apart.

**Instructions:** Divide your Go Group into two teams. The first team will start at the line on the floor. When the timer begins the first contestant will have to run to the second line and back with the pool noodle between their knees (no hands allowed). When they return to the team a second child will jump on the pool noodle, to run to the line and back. This will continue until the entire team is on the pool noodle. The team to have all members on the noodle and go to the second line the fastest wins. Teammates must work together as game requires concentrated teamwork.



# INSPECTION

## ACTIVITY TO INSPECT & EMPHASIZE THE GO ANSWER

### Supplies Needed:

- 1 Mason Jar
- 10-15 rocks
- Pebbles

### “Rock Object Lesson”

*As a small group you will be illustrating the object lesson that was done in large group.*

-Take the jar provided of stones and pebbles and empty it in the middle of the circle.

-Give each child 1 rock and 1 pebble

-Put the empty jar in the middle of the group or pass the empty jar around the circle

- When the children are ready they will put the large rock into the jar and say what should be an important thing to spend time on in their life (ex. God, Bible-reading, worship). Then they will place the small pebble in the jar and say something unimportant they spend

- **Connect time:** Go around the circle and have kids tell the group their first name and their favorite food?

- **What are ways we can show love to others?** (Answers will vary)

Review the **Go Answer** and **Go Verse** as a Group. Consider having kids look up the Go Verse in their own Bibles.

**Go Verse:** “The Lord says, ‘I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you.’” Psalm 32:8, NLT
